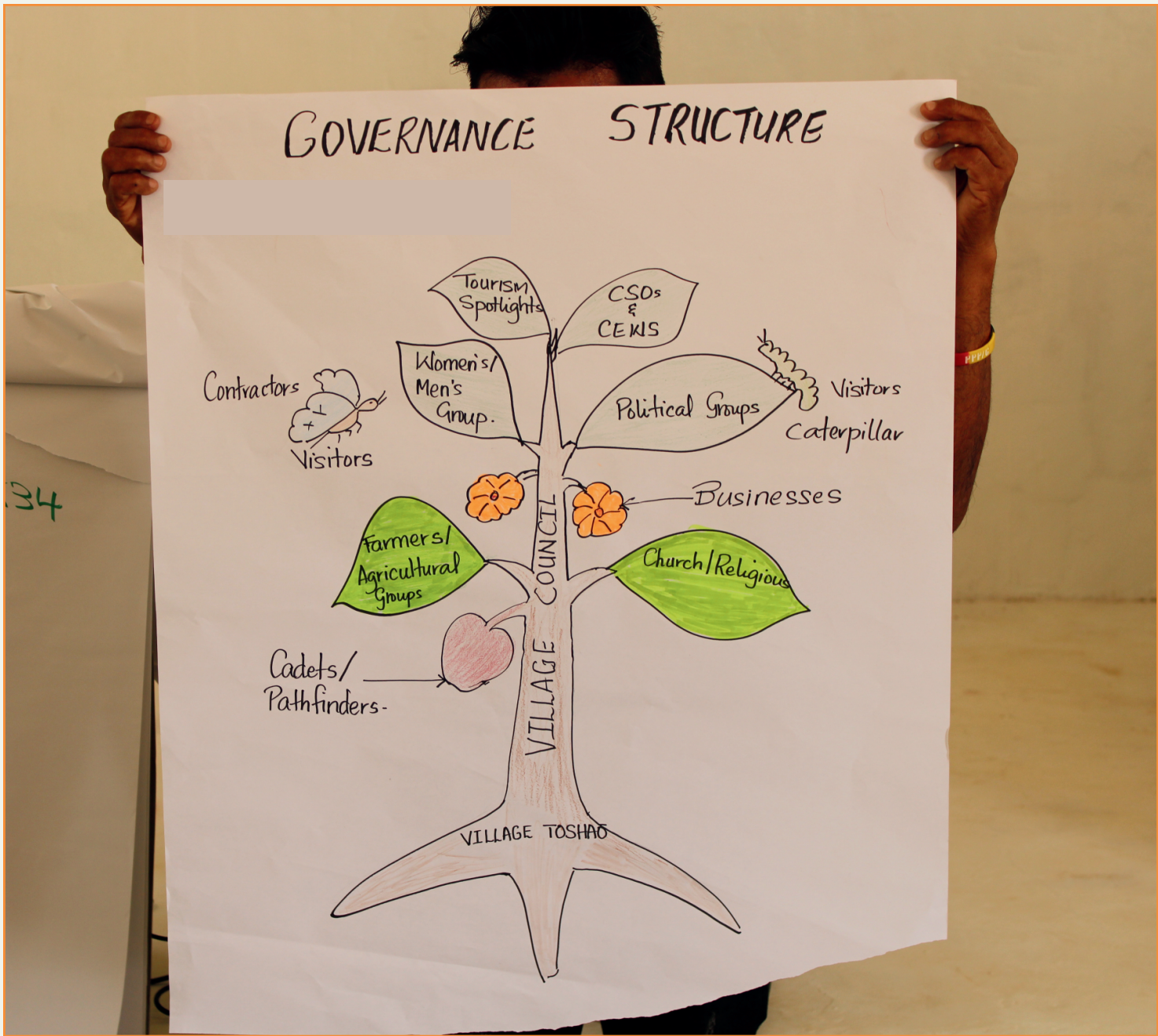




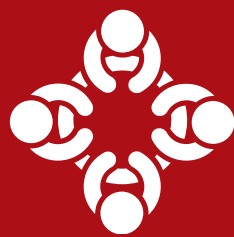
VISION STATEMENT

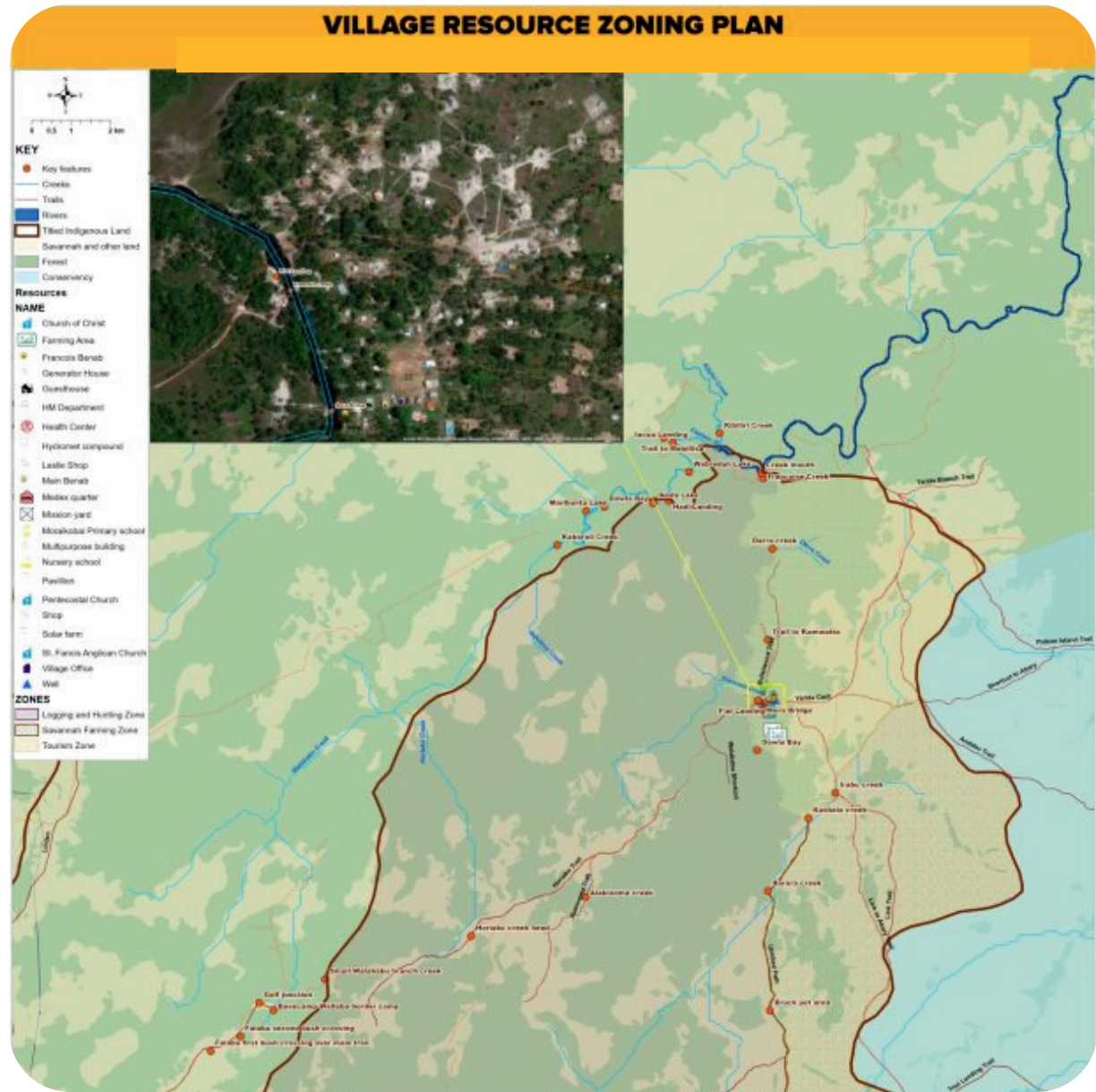


CULTURE & TRADITIONS

About the Sustainable Villages Programme

Sustainable Villages (SV) was created by communities to better achieve and sustain community- driven development that maintains and enhances the value of the community's natural, cultural and other assets.

SV requires communities to create, implement, and monitor 10-year Village Sustainability Plans (VSP) for their sustainable development. Communities use their VSPs to develop Annual Village Plans (AVPs) containing priority projects for each year. SV is built on the Village Resource Development Plan (VRDP) process implemented by the Kanuku Mountains Community Representative Group (KMCRG) in Rupununi, Region 9.



The Government of Guyana and other actors provide Financial and Technical Support to communities to implement their VSPs and achieve their Vision.

This helps to build Internal Accountability so that community members know how community resources were used and that they are satisfied with the outcomes of those expenditures/ investments.

This kind of reporting also helps the Government to ensure that support it provides to communities is impactful.
